Citing in American Psychological Association Style (6 ed) Reference Desk -2661 IMPORTANT: APA requires the following information to be italicized within a citation or reference list: titles of books, periodicals and periodical volume numbers, and microfilm publications (421 , p104 -06) Preferred fonts for APA style are 12 point Times Roman
