The Dynamics of Sexual Assault

No significant difference in the rate of rape and sexual assault among racial groups The rate of rape and sexual assault was higher among urban and low income residents of all races When men rape women of other races and ethnicities, it is more often a white assailant raping a woman of color than a man of color raping a white woman
